Crocodiles of the World and the site on which it stands on has a long history. Before the zoo was built in autumn 2013, the site was actually a farm. However, prior to moving to Brize Norton, Crocodiles of the World had another home just a few miles down the road in Crawley.

It houses the largest collection of crocodiles and alligators in the UK, with over 100 crocs from 14 species, as well as many other reptiles. The new facility is open every day (except Christmas day) from 10am to 5pm. Shaun and his passion for the world's crocodilians was featured in the hit Channel Five series 'Croc Man'.

We encourage people of all ages, nationalities, and walks of life to get involved and learn about these amazing animals. By dispelling the myth that crocodiles are vermin, or a dangerous nuisance, we can make the world a more compassionate place for crocodiles.

The aim is to stimulate public awareness about Crocodiles, Alligators, Caimans and Gharials, and open people's eyes to the incredible nature of crocodiles, and spark curiosity and awareness for the future.
